



About the position

The unit for Reconstructive plastic surgery is taking part in a diverse number of areas such as trauma, burns, and oncological surgery. Our unit have a close collaboration with specialized centers at the hospital such as Breast center, Center for skin tumors, Head/Throat/Neck oncology, thoracic surgery, trauma orthopedics, pelvic oncology as well as musculoskeletal tumors.

We are a center for surgery of gender dysphoria which is the largest of its kind in Sweden.

The open positions compose of clinical work in all areas in our team of general plastic surgery and microsurgery as well as instruction and supervision of younger colleagues.

The unit for Reconstructive plastic surgery at the Karolinska University Hospital is the only unit in Region Stockholm offering specialization in plastic surgery. Therefore, a large part of the position will be dedicated to educating future plastic surgeons in all types of plastic surgery. In addition, we also train colleagues at the hospital from other fields of specialization.

A central part of our work is conducting continuous measurements of quality outcome to identify new measurements of quality as a way to further enhance our results.

Requirements

- Swedish license to practice medicine with Swedish proof of specialization in plastic surgery.
- Documented experience in advanced plastic surgery.
- Education and license to work within EU/EES as a Doctor of Medicin, specialization in plastic surgery.

- Ph.D.
- Interest in research and education.
- Well documented and ongoing research is highly valued.
- Solid interest in quality outcome.

Terms of employment

The first step toward working at Karolinska University Hospital is to have your diploma recognized by the Swedish National Board of Health and Welfare, i.e. Socialstyrelsen who issues license to practice:

Selected candidates are expected to be highly motivated in learning Swedish as it is key in succeeding in the role.

Your employment will start with an introduction period, combined with further language studies.

Permanent

Work hours

Full time, i.e. 40 hours/week

Salary

Specialist in plastic surgery range from SEK 70 000 to SEK 90 000 SEK per month. Additional pay for inconvenient working hours and on-call duty will be added.

Salary is individually set depending on competence and previous experience.


All contracts follow local and national collective agreements.
